- ✚ A Grade Point Average (GPA) is calculated each Term . A cumulative GPA based on semester (Term) grades is calculated . The GPA is based on the following numerical equivalents for all standard courses:

Progress Reports

Progress Reports are issued each month or may also send progress reports at other times whenever they feel it necessary to inform the student and the parents of academic deficiencies or improvements. Progress Reports are sent home with the child after the approval from the administration and the parents must sign it, then the classroom teacher collects them again to put in the **Classroom Grading File**. A copy of the report is filed in the student's academic record in the school.

Report Cards(Marks)

There are **four grading** periods during the school year (Mid First Exam, Final First Term, Mid Second Term, and Final Second Term). One week after the end of the grading period, report cards will be sent home after the approval of the administration and must signed from parents, then the classroom teacher collects them again to put in the **Classroom Grading File**. It will be written on Computer by the classroom teacher.
